

Journal of Mathematics Teacher Education in Texas (JMTE) Submission Guidelines

The Journal of Mathematics Teacher Education in Texas is an online journal of the Association of Mathematics Teacher Educators in Texas (AMTE-TX), and is published three times a year: fall, spring, and summer. The editorial board will consider a wide variety of types of submissions including essays addressing questions related to theory and practice, reviews of resources for mathematics teacher educators, research summaries, book reviews, and news articles related to mathematics teacher education. We encourage submissions from researchers, practitioners, and graduate students. Each submission will be reviewed by the editorial board for relevance to the AMTE-TX membership and for quality of work. The mission of AMTE-TX is to promote the improvement of mathematics teacher education in all its aspects in the state of Texas. To that end, we have three goals:

- Provide for the professional development of mathematics teacher educators at all levels;
- Facilitate communication and networking among mathematics teacher educators at the PreK-12, technical and community college, Regional Service Centers, college and university levels, and other associated teacher education organizations; and
- Encourage, promote and support research related to mathematics teacher education.

Review Criteria

- Relevance to mathematics teacher education: To what degree is the manuscript relevant to mathematics teacher education?
- Originality: To what degree is the content of manuscript original, unique, or innovative?
- Evidence: To what degree are claims or recommendations supported by evidence, from the authors' own work or from external works cited in the manuscript?
- Clarity of expression: To what degree is the manuscript clearly written?

Manuscript submissions should support the mission and goals of AMTE-TX and be **no longer than 4 pages (double-spaced, 12-point font Times) of text or 1000 words (including references and figures/tables)**.

To submit a manuscript, complete the Google form below. You will need the following:

1. All authors' names and contact information
2. A Word file of the manuscript (blinded, without identifying information)
3. A Word file of the manuscript (not blinded)
4. Head shots of each author (optional)

Authors will receive an email confirmation that the manuscript has been received. The blinded manuscript will be sent for blind review by at least two reviewers. For ease of reading by reviewers, all figures and tables should be embedded in the correct locations in the text. All manuscripts should be formatted according to the guidelines of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (6th edition). Allow at least 4 weeks for review of submitted manuscripts.
